Medical Support



Since 2013 we are continuously supporting Poor and Needy Children . This Year was a critical year for us after facing the Lockdown. It was just a startup after the crucial period of Lockdown. The impact of Lock down was very heavy in our work and the donation as well. Some of our Donors, Volunteers and Supporters left us . We pray for the family of these Donors, Supporters, Well wishers and Volunteers. This year we provided the medical support in the category of Cancer, Heart Defect, Liver Transplant, Bone marrow transpllant, Pre Mature Babies, Various disabilities and some other disease. We are so much thankful to our donors who supported us in our mission to proceed further for our children towards their various treatment and medical requirement.

We arranged Free Medical Camps in Mass throughout the Year in Mumbai and suburb. Through these camps nearly about 10,000 children and their families were supported . We also have supported the patients wh come across the country to us. This year we have supported 25 Children infected with various critical disease (Cancer, CHD, Liver Transplant, Pmature Babies, etc.)And disables with an amount of INR 89 Lac.



Deep Kiran



Since our inception we are working for the brighter future of underprivileged children. Children are the future of any nation and as a result we work with our quote "SAVE CHILD and MAKE FUTURE". If we are educating our KIDS today then future of these kids and ours as well will be brighter. Education to children is just like "Planting a Tree today which will provide food to us in future.

Very badly impacted field during the entire LOCKDOWN was the field of education. Schools, Tutorials and all other were closed and their was a new way of Study ie. Online education by schools and tutorials. This way of education was very expensive too for Poor Kids. When there is lacking of books to children then how these children will buy a Mobile along with internet connection. This was a very hard challenge to the Poor kids, their parents and us to.

However with your support we manage to continue our Deep Kiran Project and supported our underprivileged kids towards their education. We provided laptops, Mobile (on Rent) Books stationary and fees (discounted) of their schools. On an approximate 1200 kids get supported from us through different ways in Mumbai, Thane and its suburb. On approx an amount of Rs 7Lac 41 thousand was disbursed towards the project of Deep Kiran for the educational needs of Underprivileged Children. This amount also includes the little expense of Urja Project (Free Computer Education) Urja Project was not much in demand due to lockdown this year.





Helping Disabled



When their was struggling for Bread and butter in between the common and settled person during the lockdown then what about the persons who are disable. The person who is disable cant walk or talk of see or express his of her need. Mostly these peoples are job less too. Thus any on can think about the status of such disable. We met the disable persons who were not in a condition to buy the regular medicines for them, then what about the food and water for them. In such a situation a common man was also not in a condition to support such disable person due to lockdown complications.

However with your support we manage to continue run our Helping Disabled Project in Lockdown. We did survey, identified the disable person among normal ones which was a challenging job during lockdown and recognised the their issues etc. We supported approx 100 Divyang with their tools like Walker, Crutches, Blind Stick, Hearing Aid, Wheelchair, Tricycles etc. We made 8 disables self dependent by providing Self helf business startups. We have provided approx 15 disables the JOB in different organisation as per their quality. In this year an approximate amount of rs 5.0 Lac was expend for Disable Project.



Spreading Awareness



Its always true that precaution is better than cure. During the time of Covid 19 their was A fear among all. The 2nd wave of lockdown was much more dangerous than that of 1st lockdown. Entire world was very badly affected of this covid 19 and lacks n lacks of death Were reported due to covid 19. In such a crucial period no one wanted to come out of their home. In such a period our volunteers, social workers, well wishers, donors supported us and we were able to spread awareness about covid-19. It was very important to learn about the uses of Mask, Sanitiser, social distance to keep safe all of us.

In such a crucial period we come out of our home and visited to various localities, slums, Area Where our requirement was needed. We make the people aware about various disease, their precaution and remedy/ in this due course of time we also distributed Sanitiser & Mask along with snacks to people in Mass of different area of Mumbai, Thane and suburb. On an approx 12000 people were get benefitted from our such program and on an approx an amount of Rs 8.5 Lac were disbursed for this project. The people of all the categories like Children Men and Women, Youth, Disable etc. were involved in the project and get benefitted.







In the Covid-19 period when their was lockdown and all the sources if Income were Closed how a Poor man along with his family has survived is known to that person only. These person are unable to arrange for their food and nutrition in the normal period then how the same person will arrange for him and his family in the lockdown period. In the lockdown we received so many calls daily for the Food and Nutrition support daily. It was very difficult for us too arrange for the food / dry Ration KIT for such needy persons and their family. Our donors were also in difficultly because their Job / Business was also affected very badly due to covid-19 lockdown.

We are thankful to our donors, supporters, volunteers, social workers that they supported us in such a defficult period and make us able to continue to our work. On an average daily we have distributed food packets during the period and Dry Ration Kit too to the needy ones. On an approximate an amount of Rs 51.5 lac was expended in between 6300 families. The area covered for this project was Mumbai, Thane and its suburb along with Pune & Hyderabad.



Gold Age Support



Since after ite inception in 2013 we are continuously supporting Poor and Needy Children and old age persons too. In the cities like Mumbai or other Metro cities condition of Senior Citizens are very Bad. The Children who were matured by their parents are not in a condition to take care of their parents and as a result demand of old age homes has rise in these metro cities very drastically. These Senior Citizens are also demanding some engagement for their life.

We understand the requirements of these old age persons and tried to fulfill the same . We regularly visit to old age homes and also our volunteers find some old age persons during the regular survey work who were in urgent need of requirement for their food, clothing, medicines etc. We provided Dry Ration Kit, Clothes and medical support to the old age persons. When these senior citizens get support from us were very happy and the smile on their faces was amazing. Now on a regular basis we are continuously supporting the Senior Citizens. On an approximation an amount of Rs 7.0 Lac was spent upon caring of Gold Age Persons. These persons are having very great experience which is the need of current young age citizens.
